

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF CECIL COUNTY

The Board of License Commissioners of Cecil County met in a regular session at the County Administrative Building, Conference Room, 200 Chesapeake Boulevard, Elk Room, Elkton, MD on **Wednesday, August 31, 2016** at 9:15 A.M.

NEW LICENSE:

Application received from Kevin McDevitt, Member; Station 26 LLC, T/A Station 26 Ale House, 26 S. Main Street, North East, MD 21901 for issuance of a new Class "B" Beer, Wine & Liquor Alcoholic Beverage License.

Kevin McDevitt appeared before the Board; the applicant was duly sworn by the Clerk. Mr. Wilson read the legal notice which appeared on dates of August 17 and 24, 2016. The fully executed application packet with proper fees included: signatures of 10 registered voters and property owners in District 5; a signed zoning certificate signed by Betsy Vennell, Director of Planning, Town of North East; Certification form stating Restaurant/Bar and entertainment. Mr. McDevitt stated they will have 26 taps; the building housed the first firehouse in North East and he would like to memorialize that in their honor; his plan is a relaxed, quaint place with live local entertainment. He stated the inspections were scheduled for this week and should have the occupancy permit when they are completed; he hopes to have a soft opening on September 10, the menu for this event will depend on the issuance of the occupancy permit and the liquor license. He stated he would like to create a craft beer and possibly add a pub brewery/microbrewery at some point. Chairman Snelling asked if there was anyone in attendance for or against the license; there was no one. With no further questions, Commissioner Curry made a motion to approve the issuance of the license conditioned upon issuance of the occupancy permit; Chairman Cameron seconded that motion and the Board unanimously approved the issuance of the license conditioned upon issuance of the occupancy permit.
