Wondering what to do with your natural or artificial or Christmas Tree? These items can be dropped off at all Cecil County Solid Waste Facilities for recycling

NATURAL CHRISTMAS TREES

ARE ACCEPTED AT NO FEE FROM CECIL COUNTY RESIDENTS BETWEEN DECEMBER 26—JANUARY 31.

CHRISTMAS TREES BROUGHT INTO THE LANDFILL OR STEMMERS RUN TRANSFER STATION BEFORE DEC. 26 OR AFTER JAN. 31 WILL BE CHARGED THE FEE FOR YARD WASTE.

AFTER JANUARY 31, WOODLAWN TRANSFER STATION WILL NO LONGER ACCEPT NATURAL CHRISTMAS TREES.

ALL NATURAL CHRISTMAS TREES MUST HAVE LIGHTS, STANDS, AND DECORATIONS REMOVED. CHRISTMAS TREES ARE RECYCLED INTO MULCH. NATURAL WREATHS & GARLAND WITH STRING AND OR WIRE CANNOT BE MULCHED AND ARE CONSIDERED TRASH.

ARTIFICIAL CHRISTMAS TREES & METAL STANDS

ARE ACCEPTED AT NO FEE FROM CECIL COUNTY RESIDENTS ALL YEAR AT ALL CECIL COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITIES.

ARTIFICIAL CHRISTMAS, INCLUDING PRE-LIT TREES, AND METAL STANDS GO INTO THE SCRAP METAL CONTAINER FOR RECYCLING.
