

MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS OF CECIL COUNTY

The Board of License Commissioners of Cecil County met in a regular session at the County Administrative Building, Conference Room, 200 Chesapeake Boulevard, Elk Room, Elkton, MD on **Wednesday, March 25, 2015** at 9:15 A.M.

NEW LICENSE

Application received from Ali Afghanhi, President; Timothy Thompson, Resident Agent, Perryville Sports Bar & Grille, LLC, T/A Perryville Sports Bar & Grille, 648 Broad Street, Perryville, MD 21903 for a new Class "B" Beer, Wine & Liquor Alcoholic Beverage License.

Ali Afghanhi and Timothy Thompson appeared before the Board with attorney, Dwight Thomey. The applicants were duly sworn by the Clerk; Chief Bradford read the legal notice which appeared on dates of March 11 and 18, 2015. The fully executed application packet with proper fees included: signatures of 10 registered voters and property owners in District 7; the certification form stated "The property is at 648 Broad St, Perryville, MD & consists of 11,700 sq ft of land that has a 2,882 sq ft building on it. The premises will be used for a seven day a week sports bar, that offers a full menu of regional food dishes. Mr. Thomey stated they will have the final inspection with the Health Department within the next few weeks. Chairman Snelling asked if they were doing any construction; Mr. Afghanhi stated not at this time. Settlement will take place before they open. Chairman Snelling asked if there was anyone in the audience for or against the license; there was not. With no further questions, Commissioner Curry made a motion to approve the new license conditioned upon settlement occurring; Chairman Snelling seconded that motion and the Board unanimously voted to approve the new license.

Ininder Kaur Parmar, Harminder Parmar and Avatar Singh Ghuman appeared before the Board; they were duly sworn by the Clerk. Chief Bradford read the legal notice which appeared on dates of March 11 and 18, 2015. The fully executed application packet with proper fees included: signatures of 10 registered voters and property owners in District 7; the certification form stated, "continue to operate a package goods store." Chief Bradford asked the applicants several questions pertaining to the application. Chairman Snelling asked if they had plans to change anything within the business; the applicants stated no, they will operate the business the same. Chairman Snelling asked if they were planning any renovations; the applicants stated not at this time. Chairman Snelling asked what their hours will be; Mr. Parmar stated 8 AM to 9 PM; Chief Bradford stated they are restricted by the Town of Perryville. With no further questions, Commissioner Curry made a motion to approve the transfer and renew the license; Chairman Snelling seconded that motion and the Board unanimously voted to approve the transfer.
