**REQUEST FOR CHANGE OF TRADE NAME AND VENUE**

Request for change of trade name and change of venue from Samuel L. Romero, T/A North East Chuckhouse, 2440 Pulaski Highway, North East, MD 21901

Mr. Romero appeared before the Board requesting a change of trade name and change of venue from the Chuckhouse to an Italian restaurant. He stated he will have additional employees and will be adding booths, tables and chairs. Chief Bradford asked if he is required to have any permits; he stated they are taken care of.
