

Travel Training “A Free Service”



Group or individual travel training is for people of all ages who need some help learning how to use public transportation. The training discusses bus routes, bus stops, schedules & safety. An assessment will be done to determine the participants needs. When an atmosphere of comfort is achieved the training will continue on “The Bus.”

Travel training can include a wide range of support and help by:

- Providing short-term help to familiarize you with how public transportation works in your area and giving you the confidence to use it.
- Providing longer term, regular, intensive one-to-one training to learn the most important transportation skills.
- Providing an independent lifestyle through mobility.



Travel training may be useful if you are not familiar with using public transportation, having to make new journeys, or have difficulties getting around due to a disability or an illness.
