Cecil County Bicycle Plan Public Workshops Planned for the Towns of North East and Cecilton, Maryland

WILMAPCO, in partnership with Cecil County and its Towns, Maryland Department of Transportation, State Highway Administration, residents, bicycle advocates, and interested stakeholders, has begun planning a coordinated and integrated bicycle network for both the County and municipalities.

The *Cecil County Bicycle Plan* seeks to improve quality of life for the residents and visitors of Cecil County by expanding the transportation system to foster safe, inviting, and convenient choices for bicycle commuting and recreation. The Plan will identify a bicycle network that will connect cyclists to and within each of the Towns and key destinations throughout the County.

The public is invited and encouraged to help develop local recommendations for the Towns of North East and Cecilton during public open house workshops this February. Attendees will learn about the goals of the Plan and have the opportunity to share their concerns and ideas about the proposed bicycle network and other improvements such as bike parking, signage, and safety education.

The workshops will include a presentation followed by discussion. Poster displays, maps, and comment sheets will be available to use to tell us your thoughts on how to improve countywide and local bicycle networks.
