 - b) Your private plumber must confirm that the grades for the sewer connection have been verified and that the sewer connection constructed under this Application is technically correct for this property and its use. This verification is made by way of the plumber's signature on the front section of this Application under Service Information.
 - c) When this application has been reviewed by Cecil County and all information provided for the connection(s) is found to be acceptable, the Hook-Up Charges must be paid.
 - d) When the Hook-Up Charges have been paid, you will receive a copy of the approved Application. The private utility contractor must contact the Water and Sewer Chief Inspector at 410-996-6260 forty-eight (48) hours before starting work. The work shall be accomplished under the inspection of the Division of Water and Wastewater.
