SUBJECT: COMAR 09.23.03.10 AMENDMENTS TO
TITLEBLOCK RULES

Effective July 2, 2007, pursuant to a final action taken by the Board for Professional Engineers on April 12, 2007, a professional engineer is required to include the following additional certification when signing and sealing plans, specifications, drawings, reports, or other documents.

"Professional Certification. I hereby certify that these documents were prepared or approved by me, and that I am a duly licensed professional engineer under the laws of the State of Maryland, License No. _____, Expiration Date: _____."

The titleblock, certification, seal, and signature shall appear close to each other.

The additional certification is intended to promote awareness among Maryland professional engineers regarding the status of their professional engineers' license and reduce the occurrences of practicing engineering with an expired license. A copy of the text of the regulation as it appeared in the February 2, 2007 issue of the Maryland Register is attached for your convenience.
