

Propane Tank Recycling

The Cecil County Department of Public Works, Solid Waste Management Division will be accepting all types and sizes of **EMPTY** propane tanks as well as small helium tanks used to inflate balloons at the **CENTRAL LANDFILL HOMEOWNER CONVENIENCE CENTER ONLY**. We will **NOT** be accepting oxygen, acetylene, or any other tanks besides those just mentioned.

Residents that have tanks that are unacceptable during normal operating hours can bring them for proper disposal and/or recycling during our Household Hazardous Waste Day events.

Residents may recycle their **EMPTY** propane tank during normal operating hours at the Central Landfill (regardless of whether or not it has a valve). Customers with tanks containing propane should bring them during Household Hazardous Waste Day events.

Small propane tanks used for lanterns and small grills will be accepted at all times.

All propane tanks are emptied by a certified propane tank recycling vendor, the propane is reused, and the tanks and valves are recycled.
