**Title of Bill:** Budget Transfer - Roads and Bridges Capital Improvement Program- Waibel Road Bridge and Road Improvement Projects

**Synopsis:** A Bill to amend the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 in order to transfer \$250,000 of existing bond budget authority within the Roads and Bridges Capital Improvement Program budget from the completed Replacement of Baron Road Bridge over CSX Project to the Replacement of Waibel Road Bridge (\$175,000) and Waibel Road Improvement (\$75,000) Projects.

Budget Transfer - Roads and Bridges Capital Improvement Program-  
Waibel Road Bridge and Road Improvement Projects

1           **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 505 of the Cecil County Charter, on April 1, 2015, the County  
2 Executive submitted a proposed budget to the County Council for Fiscal Year 2016; and

3           **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 506 of the Cecil County Charter, the County Council held  
4 public hearings on the proposed budget submitted by the County Executive for Fiscal Year 2016; and,

5           **WHEREAS**, in accordance with Section 507(b) of the Cecil County Charter, on June 2, 2015, the  
6 County Council adopted the budget for Fiscal Year 2016; and

7           **WHEREAS**, the County Executive is revising the Fiscal Year 2016 Capital Budget to transfer \$250,000  
8 of unencumbered savings of bond revenue and expenditure authority for Cecil County, Maryland from the  
9 completed Replacement of Baron Road Bridge over CSX Project, and transfer said bond revenue and  
10 expenditure to the Replacement of Waibel Road Bridge (\$175,000) and Waibel Road  
11 Improvements(\$75,000) and;

12           **WHEREAS**, the Replacement of Baron Road Bridge over CSX has approximately \$250,000 in excess of  
13 bond funds available to be transferred to the Replacement of Waibel Road Bridge and Road Improvement  
14 Projects and

15           **WHEREAS**, the Replacement of Waibel Road Bridge and Road Improvement projects were  
16 advertised and bid as one combined project under Bid No. 16-22-52030/52664 and bids were opened on  
17 January 21, 2016 and

18           **WHEREAS**, such appropriation is necessary to provide sufficient funds for the construction of both  
19 projects based on the lowest bid received and to adequately provide funding for the originally budgeted  
20 10% contingency and construction inspection services budgeted for both projects so the requested  
21 increased authority of \$175,000 to the Replacement of Waibel Road Bridge and \$75,000 to the Waibel  
22 Road Improvement Project is necessary to see both projects through to completion.

23           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND, IN**  
24 **LEGISLATIVE SESSION** that the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Cecil County, Maryland for  
25 Fiscal Year 2016 is hereby amended to transfer \$250,000 in bond budget authority within the Roads and  
26 Bridges Capital Project Fund from the completed Replacement of Baron Road Bridge over CSX to the  
27 Replacement of Waibel Road Bridge (\$175,000) and Waibel Road Improvement (\$75,000) Projects.

28           **AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED** that this Act shall take effect in 60 calendar days from the date it  
29 becomes law.
