1           **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 10-1201 of Subtitle Core Service Agencies, Title 10 Mental  
2 Hygiene Law, in Article X Health- General of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Core Service  
3 Agency is the designated county authority that is responsible for planning, managing, and  
4 monitoring publicly funded mental health services; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 10-1202(1) of Subtitle Core Service Agencies, Title 10 Mental  
6 Hygiene Law, in Article X Health- General of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Core Service  
7 Agency is an agent of a county government which may include a local health department; and

8           **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Section 10-1202(d)(2) of Subtitle Core Service Agencies, Title 10  
9 Mental Hygiene Law, in Article X Health- General of the Annotated Code of Maryland, the Core  
10 Service Agency must incorporate in its method of governance a mechanism for the local county  
11 mental health advisory committee to serve as the advisory committee to the core service agency;  
12 and

13           **WHEREAS**, the Cecil County Mental Health Core Service Agency Advisory Board was  
14 established to assure the existence and access to mental health services for Cecil County; and

15           **WHEREAS**, Pursuant to Article 4, Section 412 (b) of the Charter of Cecil County, the County  
16 Executive shall appoint all members of boards and commissions, subject to confirmation by the  
17 Council; and

18           **WHEREAS**, the County Executive has recommended Jean-Marie Kelly, Carol Masden,  
19 Suanne Blumberg, Cameron England, Brittany Mullins, Frederick Martin and Placida Braswell for  
20 reappointment to the Mental Health Core Service Agency Advisory Board, to a three year term,  
21 which is to expire on November 5, 2022.

22           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY,**  
23 **MARYLAND**, confirms the recommendation by the County Executive of Jean-Marie Kelly, Carol  
24 Masden, Suanne Blumberg, Cameron England, Brittany Mullins, Frederick Martin and Placida  
25 Braswell to the Mental Health Core Service Agency Advisory Board, to a three year term, which is  
26 to expire on November 5, 2022.

27           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF CECIL COUNTY, MARYLAND**, that  
28 this Resolution shall take effect on the date of its passage.
